The Fight



The General Post Office (GPO) served as the main stage for the fighting and is where the Irish Proclamation of Independence was read.



The fight lasted for 6 days and resulted in over 450 casualties, mostly civilians



Over 3,000 people were arrested in connection to the Rising. While 16 of the leaders were executed, 14 of them in Dublin at Kilmainham Gaol
